Resident Spotlight: Dorelle & Her Baby Grand Piano

Dorelle grew up playing piano. After High School, life got busy, and she took a leave of absence from piano for 20 years. In 1961 a wondrous opportunity arose when Dorelle noticed an ad in the paper for a baby grand piano for sale. Her husband thought the ad was a farce; it wasn't until both Dorelle and her husband drove to San Francisco to take a look at the piano that his mind changed. They entered this lovely home in Nob Hill and found amongst the gorgeous decor a beautiful piano in a small room. She had acquired a 1906 Chickering Quarter Grand Piano in the style of King Louis XV. This magnificent find has survived the turn of the century and still plays beautifully. "They don't make them like that anymore," Dorelle says. It is safe to say it's worth much more than \$700 now; this piece of American History makes for a priceless antique.
